THE OPPORTUNITY SPACE FESTIVAL is twelve days of free performances, workshops, and discussions created to bring new arrivals and established residents together to meet each other, build skills, or prepare to enter the job market. These activities will take place in Enskifteshagen Park, in a custom-designed temporary pavilion that was selected from an international design competition. The pavilion and programs together offer a pilot project for activating public space to support social and economic inclusion.
