



THE OPPORTUNITY SPACE

FESTIVAL is twelve days of free performances, workshops, and discussions created to bring new arrivals and established residents together to meet each other, build skills, or prepare to enter the job market. These activities will take place in Enskifteshagen Park, in a customdesigned temporary pavilion that was selected from an international design competition. The pavilion and programs together offer a pilot project for activating public space to support social and economic inclusion.



More than 30 organizations will offer festival programs in three categories: - Jobs, Skills, and Entrepreneurship:

- to connect job seekers and employers, and to help people build skills to enter the job market
- Food and Cultural Exchange: for long-time residents and new arrivals to meet and find common ground
- The Inclusive City: to explore how design can help create more socially and economically inclusive cities.



The festival is for everyone - new arrivals and long-time residents, job seekers and employers, young and old. The festival is all about trying something new, learning from each other, and connecting with people you never thought you would meet.

Take a hip-hop dance workshop or try open mic stand-up comedy. Get advice on how to start a business or nail that big job interview. Tell us about your worst job ever or sit down and talk to a total stranger for 10 minutes about immigration. Find your opportunity.


