# **FIKA**

As a fika lover, you won't be disappointed in Möllan. *Kaffebaren på Möllan* is open 364 days per year, and is easily recognised with its red benches outside. Here, artist Magda Lundberg often sits and sketches her popular cartoon *Fåglarna*. "It's a fast track to the real Möllan, sitting here, looking out over the square. You want to return day after day, for the coffee, for a chat with the amazing staff, and to people watch", she says. Just a stone throw away, you'll find *Farina*, an Italian-French bakery with both maritozzi (cream filled brioche) and a mouth-watering croissant-ish: sugar dipped and filled with a lemon curd.
